





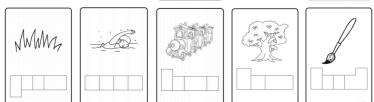

Screw up paper or aluminum foil to make your lightweight balls. Stand from a distance can you hit the target? Move back a step each time - see how skilful you are?

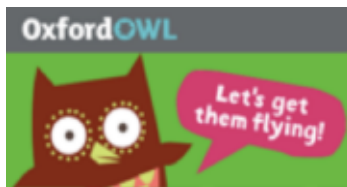

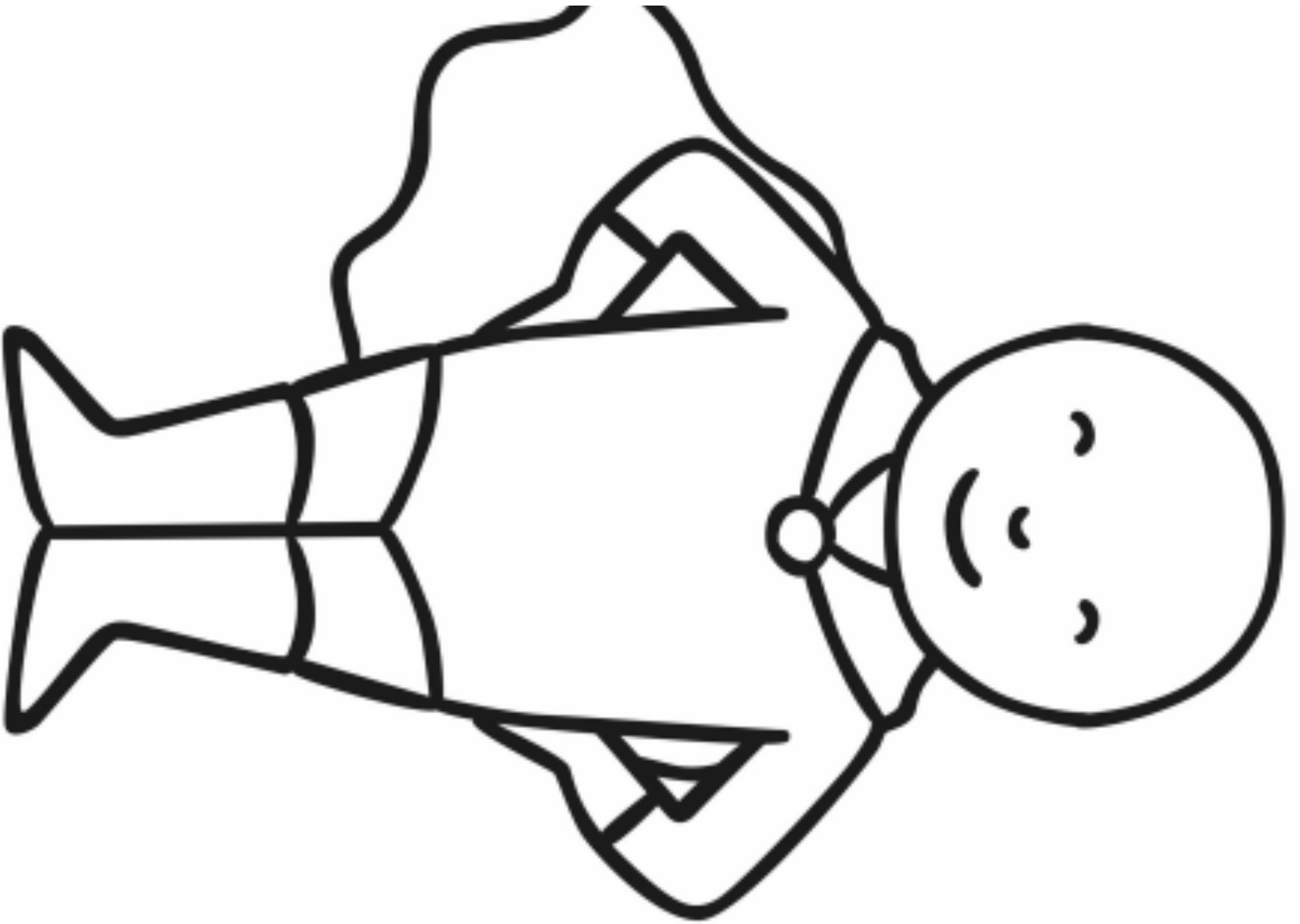
